DAILY PRAYER FOCUS

DAY 1 – A HEART FULLY SURRENDERED

Pray that your heart would be yielded completely to God, open to His will above personal preference.

ROMANS 12:1

I appeal to you therefore, brothers, by the mercies of God, to present your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and acceptable to God, which is your spiritual worship.

PRAYER STARTER

Lord, I surrender my heart, my plans, and my resources fully to You today.

PERSONAL REFLECTION

DAY 2 – ETERNAL PERSPECTIVE

Ask God to help you see beyond the present moment and value what will last forever.

COLOSSIANS 3:2

Set your minds on things that are above, not on things that are on earth.

PRAYER STARTER

God, lift my eyes from temporary things to eternal priorities.

PERSONAL REFLECTION

DAY 3 – GRATITUDE FOR GOD'S FAITHFULNESS

Thank God for how He has already provided for and sustained the church.

LAMENTATIONS 3:23

Great is your faithfulness.

PRAYER STARTER

Father, thank You for Your constant faithfulness to me and to our church.

PERSONAL REFLECTION

DAY 4—REPENTANCE AND SPIRITUAL RENEWAL

Pray for personal repentance and a renewed walk with Christ.

PSALM 51:10

Create in me a clean heart, O God, and renew a right spirit within me.

PRAYER STARTER

Lord, renew my heart and restore a right spirit within me.

PERSONAL REFLECTION

DAY 5—TRUST IN GOD'S PROVISION

Ask God to deepen your trust that He is the ultimate provider of all resources.

PHILIPPIANS 4:19

And my God will supply every need of yours according to his riches in glory in Christ Jesus.

PRAYER STARTER

God, help me trust You fully with every need and concern.

PERSONAL REFLECTION

DAY 6—FREEDOM FROM FEAR AND ANXIETY

Pray that fear of uncertainty would be replaced with faith

ISAIAH 41:10

*fear not, for I am with you;
be not dismayed, for I am your God;
I will strengthen you, I will help you,
I will uphold you with my righteous righthand.*

PRAYER STARTER

Lord, replace my fear with confidence in Your presence.

PERSONAL REFLECTION

DAY 7 – UNITY IN THE CHURCH BODY

Ask God to bring unity of spirit, purpose, and vision within the congregation.

PSALM 133:1

*Behold, how good and pleasant it is
when brothers dwell in unity!*

PRAYER STARTER

God, unite our church around Your will and Your mission.

PERSONAL REFLECTION

DAY 8—WISDOM FOR CHURCH LEADERSHIP

Pray for our pastors, church board, and leaders to have clarity, humility, and discernment.

JAMES 1:5

If any of you lacks wisdom, let him ask God, who gives generously to all without reproach, and it will be given him.

PRAYER STARTER

Lord, grant wisdom and discernment to those who lead us.

PERSONAL REFLECTION

DAY 9 – OBEDIENT AND WILLING HEARTS

Ask God to prepare hearts to respond in obedience, not reluctance.

1 SAMUEL 3:10

And the Lord came and stood, calling as at other times, "Samuel! Samuel!" And Samuel said, "Speak, for your servant hears."

PRAYER STARTER

God, help me listen carefully and respond obediently.

PERSONAL REFLECTION

DAY 10—SUPERNATURAL FAVOR

Pray for supernatural favor to rest upon our church and its leaders – favor that opens doors that no one can shut, aligns hearts with His purposes, and accomplishes far more than human effort alone could achieve.

PSALM 90:17

Let the favor of the Lord our God be upon us, and establish the work of our hands; yes, establish the work of our hands!

PRAYER STARTER

Lord, I ask for Your supernatural favor to go before us, open the right doors and accomplish only what you can do for Your glory.

PERSONAL REFLECTION



DAY 11—A SPIRIT OF JOYFUL SACRIFICE

Ask God to cultivate joy in sacrificial obedience..

ACTS 20:35

In all things I have shown you that by working hard in this way we must help the weak and remember the words of the Lord Jesus, how he himself said, 'It is more blessed to give than to receive.'

PRAYER STARTER

God, give me joy as I sacrifice for Your purposes.

PERSONAL REFLECTION

DAY 12—STEWARSHIP OF ALL GOD HAS GIVEN

Pray for wisdom to steward time, talents, and treasures faithfully.

1 CORINTHIANS 4:2

Moreover, it is required of stewards that they be found faithful.

PRAYER STARTER

Lord, help me steward everything You've entrusted to me well.

PERSONAL REFLECTION

DAY 13—COURAGE TO STEP OUT IN FAITH

Ask God for bold faith to follow where He leads.

2 CORINTHIANS 5:7

For we walk by faith, not by sight.

PRAYER STARTER

God, give me courage to step forward in faith.

PERSONAL REFLECTION

DAY 14— GOD'S GLORY ABOVE ALL ELSE

Pray that every aspect of the ministry of our church would point to God's glory, not human recognition.

ROMANS 11:36

For from him and through him and to him are all things. To him be glory forever. Amen.

PRAYER STARTER

Lord, may everything I do bring glory to You alone.

PERSONAL REFLECTION

DAY 15 – IMPACT ON FUTURE GENERATIONS

Pray for children, students, and future believers who will be shaped by this ministry.

PSALM 78:4

*We will not hide them from their children,
but tell to the coming generation
the glorious deeds of the Lord, and his might,
and the wonders that he has done.*

PRAYER STARTER

God, use our obedience to shape future generations for You.

PERSONAL REFLECTION

DAY 16—REACHING THE LOST

Ask God to use the church's resources to draw people to saving faith in Christ.

LUKE 19:10

The Son of Man came to seek and to save the lost.

PRAYER STARTER

Lord, use our church to turn many hearts toward you.

PERSONAL REFLECTION

DAY 17—A LASTING GOSPEL WITNESS

Pray that the outcomes of the campaign would produce eternal fruit.

JOHN 15:16

You did not choose me, but I chose you and appointed you that you should go and bear fruit and that your fruit should abide, so that whatever you ask the Father in my name, he may give it to you.

PRAYER STARTER

God, let this work bear fruit that lasts forever.

PERSONAL REFLECTION

DAY 18—FAITH THAT INSPIRES OTHERS

Ask God to let your faith encourage and strengthen others in the body.

HEBREWS 10:24

And let us consider how to stir up one another to love and good works,

PRAYER STARTER

Lord, let my faith encourage others to follow You.

PERSONAL REFLECTION

DAY 19—COMMITMENT WITH INTEGRITY

Pray for faithfulness in keeping commitments made before God.

MATTHEW 5:37

Let what you say be simply 'Yes' or 'No.'

PRAYER STARTER

God, help me honor every commitment I make before You.

PERSONAL REFLECTION

DAY 20—THANKSGIVING IN ADVANCE

Thank God ahead of time for what He will do through obedience and faith.

1 THESSALONIANS 5:18

give thanks in all circumstances; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you.

PRAYER STARTER

Lord, I thank You in advance for all You will do.

PERSONAL REFLECTION

DAY 21—LIVING FOR ETERNITY

Pray that your life—and your church—would be fully devoted to eternal purposes.

MATTHEW 6:20

but lay up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where neither moth nor rust destroys and where thieves do not break in and steal.

PRAYER STARTER

God, help me live fully and faithfully for eternity.

PERSONAL REFLECTION

PRAYER FOCUS

God has put us on the earth at this specific time for a reason. Knowing this, we can look at those around us at this time in history and take personal responsibility to pray.

I urge, then, first of all, that petitions, prayers, intercession and thanksgiving be made for all people—for kings and all those in authority, that we may live peaceful and quiet lives in all godliness and holiness. This is good, and pleases God our Savior, who wants all people to be saved and to come to a knowledge of the truth.

1 TIMOTHY 2:1-4 NIV

Pray for those in authority and those under your authority. Pray for those in your family and your circle of influence. Write down the names of specific people and pray for them.
